Dear Parents

Following conversations today with the Health Protection Agency, their advice is to still keep school open after the outbreak of dysentery. The infection seems to be affecting mainly Y6 pupils and siblings. I have therefore made a decision to close school on Wednesday and Thursday to Y6 pupils and their siblings. My intention is to re-open school to Y6 and their siblings on Friday. Please contact school for confirmation.

If your child feels unwell with any of the symptoms mentioned in the leaflet which was distributed yesterday, please contact school so that we can inform the Agency who are monitoring the situation.

On a separate note, we will unfortunately have to withdraw from the Y5/6 swimming gala tomorrow.
