Dear Parents

The Year 6 residential visit is to **Lea Valley YH just north of London**, from **Monday 28 May to Thursday 31 May 2012**. We will be staying at the youth hostel for 4 days (3 nights). The itinerary includes visits to:

- The Olympic Park
- The Olympic classroom
- London bus tour
- The Tower of London
- Lea Valley Watersports centre
- Walks

I hope that your child will participate in this visit because it will cover elements of the science, geography and history curriculum as well as allowing him/her to socialise with peers and adults in an environment outside the home and school. It is a valuable experience in the preparation for secondary education.

The total cost of the visit, which includes accommodation, food, transport by coach and entry to the above venues is £129, which school has heavily subsidised due to the current economic climate. During the year the class will organise two minor fundraising events for the rest of the school, with all proceeds going to the trip.

A deposit of £50 will be required by **18 November**, a further £50 by **16 March** and £29 by **4 May**. A saving scheme will operate - your savings card will be issued upon the receipt of your deposit and then it will be required with each payment that is made. You may wish to make weekly payments. Cheques should be made payable to Barugh Green Primary School (BMBC). We do put aside a small amount of money to help genuine situations where families may struggle to pay the full amount. In such cases, please see Mr Gilmore, before the 18 November as it is difficult to help after this date.
